

1st house - Ascendant (ASC)

Physical personality

Ascendant (ASC) - Symbolises basic personality traits such as physical appearance, temperament, behaviour, relationship to life and the first impression the person gives.

Ascendant in Scorpio (Scorpio ruler is Pluto)

People with Scorpio on the Ascendant need to fight against dark and destructive power in their life. For some, this power can also come from within, in the form of jealousy, envy or lust for power. The dark and hidden things in the soul must come out. It can be reflected in artwork, for example. ... more ->

10th house - Medium Coeli (MC)

Career, prestige and reputation

Medium Coeli (MC) - Symbolises social status, career, reputation, honours, fame, success, authoritative personality, father.

10th house in Leo (Leo ruler is Sun)

People with Leo on the tenth house cusp have strong career ambitions. They are proud of their social status. Leo is dominated by the Sun so this position makes the personality, leadership skills and executive power of these people more profound. It is very important for them to be well-respected. Being acknowledged in their society is the most important thing in their lives, so they have to be careful not to become too conceited and stuck-up. If they manage to stay open-minded and have broad view on things, they will have a good chance of getting into power. Their abilities and success will bring admiration of others. These people are the happiest when they run their own business. If this is not possible, they will try to become the leaders and boss others around. They do not do well as team members. Interpretations - Planets in Signs, Planets in Houses

- **Planets** describe a certain process of what is happening - eg. Mars fights, Saturn limits, Jupiter expands..
- **Sign** in which the planet is located determines how the planet is manifesting itself, for example Mars may manifest itself in a way Aries would behave (vigorously and irritably) or in the manner of Taurus (more slowly, gradually and consistently)
- **Houses** show special areas of everyday life, in which all this takes place. Location in a house shows whether, for example Mars manifests in relationships (7th house), employment (6th house), family (4th house) or elsewhere.

Signs show us **how** it is hapenning;
Houses show us **where** it is happening.

☉ **Sun** - Self, individuality, personality

The Sun symbolises a personal identity. It shows us areas where the person should learn to be independent, where he should fulfill his potential, differentiate himself from others and shine. The position of the Sun may tell us which profession would best suit the character of a person.

Sun in ♋ Cancer

Cancer is ruled by the Moon, which gives people born under this sign great emotional sensitivity. They are thus often reserved and shy. Their reasoning, thinking and behaviour are very dependent on their mood, and this is the reason why they like to depend on people with strong personalities and choose partners they can lean on. more ->

Sun in the 8th House

The Sun in the eighth house gives people profound creativity and a broader understanding of life. The Sun gives these people perceptiveness and sensitivity for the values of others. Mercury in ♊ Gemini

People with Mercury in Gemini have young minds and they are full of energy. They want to discover new things, move from one argument to another, try different hobbies and work, and have discussions with interesting people. They will usually try many different jobs, and do all these jobs with enthusiasm and commitment. These people are also talented public speakers. It can be said that Mercury feels well in all air signs, but it can be a bit shallow in them - these people do not like to study things into the greatest detail. Venus in ♊ Gemini

Gemini is a sign of youth, and these people have a strong urge to prevent stagnation and maintain flexibility in their relationships. They believe that relationship without freedom is deemed to fail. Venus in the Gemini can be more compared with love bud rather than love in a full bloom, so it must be given the opportunity to bloom. Mars in ♊ Gemini

Mars in the Gemini never stops moving. These people have many projects and ideas, but their energy is fragmented because air signs are known for not wanting to put up a fight. ♃ Jupiter - Happiness, optimism, expansion

Jupiter symbolises growth, expansion, laws, faith and ethics that guide it. It represents a sense for development and support, which can lead to opportunities, wealth and faith. However, if Jupiter is damaged, the person becomes immoral and extremist.

Jupiter in ♉ Taurus

People with Jupiter in Taurus believe in the importance of financial security and social status, and the comfort these values provide. To a greater or lesser extent, they are capable of attracting wealth in some way. Jupiter in Taurus brings the question of what to do with money. Growth through stabilisation means that the improvement of material conditions is closely related to the understanding that stability is a natural state and it is maintained by allowing resources to flow in as well as out. In order to find the golden middle way between these extremes, sooner or later they will have to find a way to call the wisdom of the Ancient Soul within themselves. Uranus in ♍ Virgo

(Note: Uranus is a slow transpersonal planet and may remain in a single sign for up to many years. The description of Uranus in Virgo is therefore valid for the entire generation of people and is very general. The characteristic of the personality is in the description of Uranus in the 10th house.)

Uranus in Virgo aggravates some negative traits, for example perfectionism. These people are ecological and they promote alternative medicine. They appreciate new technologies and they often participate in their research and application. They long for social justice and they may become left-wing radicals or unionists.

Neptune is called the Lord of the Invisible Empire, which is a mysterious name of a mysterious planet. Perhaps we could describe it as a dimension of life that cannot be experienced by our five senses and we can only understand and perceive it in our imagination.

Neptune in ♏ Scorpio

(Note: Neptune is a slow transpersonal planet and may remain in a single sign for up to many years. The description of Neptune in Scorpio is therefore valid for the entire generation of people and is very general. The characteristic of the personality is in the description of Neptune in the 1st house.)

Neptune in Scorpio gives people occult abilities and the desire to discover secret spiritual doctrines. These people have a great creative potential, but it is hidden and they are not aware of it. It may be difficult to activate this potential.

Neptune in the 1st House

Neptune in the first house has an indirect influence on the personality. This position suggests people who are affected by influences that are unobservable by others. They are easily influenced intuitive people who usually rely on their spiritual qualities and abilities. They often become victims of self-deception, illusions or confusion. Specific goals may be missing in their lives so they tend to miss their opportunities or waste time. They sometimes do not know who they are and they seek support and life guidance from others. ♇ Pluto - Transformation, regeneration, power

Pluto is the planet of death and rebirth. It is the end of all things, it is the Judgment Day. It can give rise to obsessions or convictions. On the dark end of its spectrum it can manifest as "succumbing to the urge," or it can create an individual who has the ability to get to the core of things, destroy negative things and bring on healing and transformation.

Pluto in ♍ Virgo

(Note: Pluto is a slow transpersonal planet and may remain in a single sign for up to many years. The description of Pluto in Virgo is therefore valid for the entire generation of people and is very general. The characteristic of the personality is in the description of Pluto in the 10th house.)

People with Pluto in Virgo are accurate and methodical. If the planet is damaged, they may start looking for faults and become too strict about adherence to rules. They can achieve transformation by analysing.

Pluto in the 10th House

Pluto in the tenth house suggests a person who has a strong will and need to achieve success in his career. Pluto in this house suggests a career in a scientific field, in healing or medicine, or in a profession where one can deal with powerful individuals, for example politics. ♊ North Node and South Node

The Lunar Nodes aren't planets, but rather astrology mathematical points, that are directly opposite each other in the chart. It is said, that your life purpose is encoded between them - in the line between North Node and South Node. The South Node indicates your comfort zone, your habitual place, while your North Node shows life lessons and what you're striving for in this lifetime. Both Lunar Nodes are almost always retrograde.

North Node (Mean) in ♋ Cancer - South Node in Capricorn

North Node in Cancer brings the conflict between family and profession, home and public, proximity and distance, inner experience and external obligations. These people need to find happiness in their family and in their

spiritual life. They need to be interested in their family, roots, nation and homeland. They also need to turn to their own feelings and emotional needs, to their inner world and mental images. Watch out for exaggerated ambition and external recognition instead of developing inner peace.

North Node (Mean) in the 8th House - South Node in the 2nd House

North Node in the eight house brings the conflict between spiritual and material property, between acknowledgement of transience and the desire to own something.

These people need to accept transience and to recognize that death is a great teacher. They should not base their life on false material values and build on them. They should explore spiritual values instead. They should stop avoiding conflicts and they should not stay in comfortable sterility.

Beware of greed and clinging to material assets that are proven and secure. Actual values lie deeper.

♁ **Lilith** - Black Moon - Fascination and Denial

Lilith is a fictional point - the second empty focal point of elliptical orbit of the Moon around the Earth.

In mythology, Lilith refused to submit to Adam, rebelled against the connection between Adam and Eve, decided to escape from the world of people and made a connection with Satan.

In astrology, Lilith symbolises either fascination or refusal of topics with which she is connected with. Both, the fascination or the rejection of the given topics, can eventually engulf the person and take him "away" from the human world.

Lilith (Mean) in ♐ Sagittarius

Rejecting borders and laws; moving away from values.

Faith and uselessness is the main topic of this position. These people have a great desire to learn the truth about things and the spiritual world, but they are often disappointed. It is difficult for them to believe in God, they are often atheists or, on the contrary, they become fanatical. Both is possible. They seek balance between spiritual and secular life. There may even be resistance to the Church. If you ever lie to these people, you will never get their trust again. It is necessary to speak with them openly from young age.

Beware of injuries to thighs, hips and gall bladder.

Lilith (Mean) in the 2nd House

Clear ambiguity between obsession and rejection of material goods.



♄ **Chiron** - Wounded Healer, inner teacher

Chiron is an asteroid between Saturn and Uranus. Its orbit is very unusual and represents a bridge between material and spiritual worlds.

According to mythology, Chiron was a great healer, wise teacher and one of the immortal Centaurs. Unfortunately, he was "deadly" injured by a poisonous arrow by Heracles, his favourite disciple. He was suffering in great pain but he could not die. Finally, he gave up his immortality for the benefit of Prometheus who was also suffering, and Chiron was sent to the underworld. In the underworld Zeus had mercy for him and he raised him to the heaven.

In astrology, Chiron symbolises our unhealable injuries and incurable trauma. However, if a person, instead of drowning in his own trauma, is able to accept the trauma and help others who are also suffering, and accept that suffering is part of life, then Chiron may be the key to wisdom, or even to some sort of "Initiation Gate".

Chiron in ♓ Pisces

There people believe that the world is a place of great suffering and that there is physical and moral misery, illness, violence and injustice all around us. Even sympathy with suffering people can become unhealable injury because this suffering never ends.

These people can react with disgust and resignation, or on contrary, by helping others because by helping others these people can also heal their own irreparable injury.

Chiron in the 5th House

Whether these people create - a piece of art, a novel, a scientific text, or start a business - it is not accepted by others with recognition that they believe they deserve. There is always some defect: it is out of date, it is prejudiced or it does not attract enough attention. The more unique and distinctive are the fruits of their creativity, the more painful is their trauma of rejection.

♌ - Sun Conjunction Mercury (6°41', Applying)

There can only be conjunction between the Sun and Mercury. People with this aspect are subjective and creative; they can express their ideas well and they are often very artistic. This is a great aspect for artists who perform on stage. These people are intellectuals, but their thinking is very subjective and they can sometimes lack objectivity or the ability to see things from the outside.

♌ - Sun Conjunction Venus (2°59', Separating)

There can only be conjunction between the Sun and Venus. This aspect highlights feminine characteristics of both sexes. It also supports artistic and creative inclinations. These people are often optimistic and they enjoy the company of other people. They have a good taste for fashionable clothes.

♌ - Sun Trine Saturn (4°33', Applying)

This harmonious aspect give these people the ability to work hard and take on responsibility at work, so they are usually very responsible. However, they often have low self-concept and tendencies to be too hard on themselves.

♌ - Moon Opposition Mars (7°31', Applying)

These people often suffer from emotional tension and they are ruthless and indecisive. They love conflicts at home and they know how to win them. They are bossy, they lead adventurous life and find it hard to conform and settle down.

♌ - Moon Opposition Jupiter (9°23', Separating)

This aspect causes constantly increasing needs - for emotions, care and comfort. These people are introverts who seek intense religious life. They are very dependent on external conditions and they need to find their purpose of life.

♌ - Moon Square Saturn (9°26', Applying)

This aspect creates people who are unable to express their feelings and prefer to hide behind a mask they create. They need a stable home where they can feel safe. In their family life they tend to artificially create too many duties. They are inclined to depressions.

♌ - Mercury Conjunction Venus (3°42', Applying)

This conjunction gives people good manners and mental balance. They can express themselves well and they are convincing. Their views are also well-balanced. Their thinking is often so rational that they are not able to express their feelings too openly.

♌ - Mars Square Saturn (1°54', Applying)

This aspect brings one personality trait that is not very constructive - these people are often unable to finish things they have started, even when it is important for them. They can get excited about it but then they quickly give up when they see obstacles along the way that appear to happen "by chance". These people often have a weaker will which reduces their stamina. It is precisely the problem that they should learn to deal with in life - they should learn to be more persistent and firm and to complete things they have started.

♌ - Mars Square Uranus (3°29', Applying)

This aspect is responsible for people who are very eccentric, individualistic and sometimes even pathologically independent. They admire marginal religions or marginal political groups, but they are usually unable to get involved in these groups because they are very restless and unstable. However, if they develop their practical skill they can successfully complete their plans. They often have mood swings and they want considerable changes to the established order. They long for freedom and they are able to sacrifice anything for it.

♌ - Jupiter Opposition Neptune (0°47', Separating)

This aspect may give people restless soul and a tendency to wander. They do not like to settle down and they do not have clear goals in life. They are able to make big sacrifices for their ideals, but they should be careful not to be naive and not live in their fantasy world. In a better case scenario, these people fanatically push higher universal laws into the existing world order; in the worst case scenario, they work around the secular law with the help of higher universal laws.

♌ - Jupiter Trine Pluto (4°20', Separating)

This harmonious aspect gives people persistence, decisiveness and desire for self-realization. These people often become rich when they become adults.

 - **Saturn Opposition Uranus** (1°35', Separating)

This aspect is responsible for the fact that these people often have no principles and that they are chaotic. However, it is also possible that they have highly developed sense of order, which is not acceptable to other people. Their behaviour is usually unpredictable. These people are often too strict and stiff. Their logic is frequently too rigid and they sometimes also look down on other people.

 - **Uranus Conjunction Pluto** (5°13', Applying)

This conjunction is an aspect of a generation (lasting several years) and it always accompanies profound changes in human history. This conjunction creates strong, original personalities with genius ideas which will impress wide circles of people throughout the society.

 - **Neptune Sextile Pluto** (3°33', Applying)

This harmonious aspect is long-lasting and it affects peace-making attitudes. In connection with other aspects it further enhances peace-building and transformative actions on global scale.

Other aspects

 - **Ascendant Trine Sun** (6°06', Separating)

This aspect indicates a relationship between behaviour and true nature: there is a certain harmony between behaviour and the true nature of the person.

 - **Ascendant Trine Saturn** (1°33', Separating)

The positive thing about this aspect is that these people are prudent and honest.

 - **Ascendant Sextile Uranus** (0°02', Applying)

The positive thing about this aspect is that it gives people skilful and original behaviour.

 - **Ascendant Trine Node** (4°21', Separating)

Interpretation is being prepared.

 - **MC Square Jupiter** (3°52', Applying)

The positive thing about this aspect is that these people believe in their ability to achieve success. This ability helps them grow. The negative side of this aspect is that they often overestimate their skills that are frequently not as great as their ambitions.

 - **MC Square Neptune** (3°05', Applying)

The positive thing about this aspect is that it gives people intuition that helps them find their life path. The negative side of this aspect is that these people may lose their life direction because they are not clearly aware of their real abilities.

 - **Node Conjunction Sun** (1°45', Applying)

This conjunction greatly increases the importance of the sign and the house in which it appears. The capabilities, potentials and tasks that are related to it can be responsible for a significant boom.

 - **Node Conjunction Venus** (4°44', Separating)

The positive thing about this aspect is that these people are often pleasant, graceful, sexy and affectionate. They can appreciate beauty and they like art. They have a good taste. This harmonious connection forms the focal point of their life and it helps them achieve their goals. They have somewhat feminine radiating power that is very valuable and deserves to be acknowledged and developed.

The negative side of this aspect is that it can be difficult for these people to find inner peace because their love life is in constant conflict with the direction of their life. They can experience feelings of unfulfillment and they may have great need for affection that is very hard to satisfy.

 - **Node Trine Saturn** (2°47', Separating)

The positive thing about this aspect is that these people are focused on overcoming challenges in their life. They are consistent, aware of their responsibilities, and they walk tirelessly along their life path. They have high standards for themselves and they set ambitious goals. They are able to overcome their limits.

Declination aspects - Parallels and Contra-Parallels

Parallels and Contra-Parallels are aspects, which refer to degrees of declination above or below the celestial equator.

- Parallel is similar to a conjunction, but usually provides benefits.
- Contra-Parallel is said to be similar to the opposition, but weaker.

Note: The following parallel and contra-parallel interpretations are the same as the interpretations used for the conjunction and opposition.

|| - **Sun Parallel Mercury** (0°14')

There can only be conjunction between the Sun and Mercury. People with this aspect are subjective and creative; they can express their ideas well and they are often very artistic. This is a great aspect for artists who perform on stage. These people are intellectuals, but their thinking is very subjective and they can sometimes lack objectivity or the ability to see things from the outside.

⚡ - **Moon Contra-Parallel Jupiter** (0°23')

This aspect causes constantly increasing needs – for emotions, care and comfort. These people are introverts who seek intense religious life. They are very dependent on external conditions and they need to find their purpose of life.

|| - **Venus Parallel Mars** (0°29')

This conjunction brings a lot of sensitivity and these people often get easily offended. They like frequent social, physical and sexual experiences. They are popular and full of energy. Their confidence often borders on selfishness. They are quick-tempered but they do not stay angry for long. They like harmonious relationships so they want to make up quickly.

|| - **Mars Parallel Pluto** (0°48')

This conjunction brings stubbornness and decisiveness and these people practically never listen to other people's advice. They are born leaders and they often get involved in politics. In the past they also often got involved in church. Mars in this position is often responsible for manipulation with others. It gives people an exceptionally strong and magical will. From a psychological point of view, conjunction of Mars and Pluto creates a guilt complex so these people find it hard to accept their complex soul and they are constantly blaming themselves.

⚡ - **Jupiter Contra-Parallel Neptune** (0°59')

This aspect may give people restless soul and a tendency to wander. They do not like to settle down and they do not have clear goals in life. They are able to make big sacrifices for their ideals, but they should be careful not to be naive and not live in their fantasy world. In a better case scenario, these people fanatically push higher universal laws into the existing world order; in the worst case scenario, they work around the secular law with the help of higher universal laws.

|| - **Ascendant Parallel Neptune** (1°00')

The positive thing about this aspect is that these people are intuitive and understanding. The negative side of this aspect is that they are impetuous and they find it hard to adapt to new situations. They should stay away from alcohol.

⚡ - **MC Contra-Parallel Moon** (1°01')

This aspect can bring instability in professional life and these people often have unstable professions.

|| - **Node Parallel Sun** (0°01')

This conjunction greatly increases the importance of the sign and the house in which it appears. The capabilities, potentials and tasks that are related to it can be responsible for a significant boom.

|| - **Node Parallel Mercury** (0°15')

The positive thing about this aspect is that it gives people intelligence and good life orientation. They enjoy searching for the background of their motives and they are able to critically and creatively deal with their personality. They are open towards others. They accept criticism easily and they do not avoid conflicts. They manage life challenges with the help of their analytical and logical thinking.

The negative side of this aspect is that these people may have poor focus on their life path. Their intellect always finds "good reasons" that stop them from focusing on a set goal. This is the reason why these people are often stubborn, have defensive attitudes and why they cling to things that put them at disadvantage.
