

## Interpretations - Ascendant, Medium Coeli, House rulers

Before reading the following interpretation done by a computer it is good to note that any planet position or aspect mentioned in your horoscope may be insignificant. You should always remember the rule:

**Nothing should be evaluated separately, things should always be considered in a broader context** and with regard to other planet positions and aspects of the horoscope.



### 1st house - Ascendant (ASC)

#### Physical personality

Ascendant (ASC) - Symbolises basic personality traits such as physical appearance, temperament, behaviour, relationship to life and the first impression the person gives.

#### Ascendant in Virgo (Virgo ruler is Mercury)

People with Virgo Ascendant develop the best through spiritual analysis, discernment and self-criticism. Application of knowledge must be appropriate and consider the benefits that it brings - it must be beneficial to the public. The focus is interest in body and health. It is necessary to carefully select negative experiences in the person's mind and get rid of them. #### Interpretations - Planets in Signs, Planets in Houses

- **Planets** describe a certain process of what is happening - eg. Mars fights, Saturn limits, Jupiter expands..
- **Sign** in which the planet is located determines how the planet is manifesting itself, for example Mars may manifest itself in a way Aries would behave (vigorously and irritably) or in the manner of Taurus (more slowly, gradually and consistently)
- **Houses** show special areas of everyday life, in which all this takes place. Location in a house shows whether, for example Mars manifests in relationships (7th house), employment (6th house), family (4th house) or elsewhere.

#### ☉ Sun - Self, individuality, personality

## ♊ Lunar Nodes - North Node and South Node

The Lunar Nodes aren't planets, but rather astrology mathematical points, that are directly opposite each other in the chart. It is said, that your life purpose is encoded between them - in the line between North Node and South Node. The South Node indicates your comfort zone, your habitual place, while your North Node shows life lessons and what you're striving for in this lifetime. Both Lunar Nodes are almost always retrograde.

### ♊ North Node (Mean) in ♓ Pisces - South Node in Virgo

North Node in Pisces brings the conflict between transcendental effort and everyday reality, between chaos and order, and between spirituality and reason.

These people need to open up to their spirituality and imagination. They need to escape the constraints of the usual and explainable and be open to the unusual and unexplainable. They need to go beyond the rational and analytical, develop imaginative powers and spiritual awareness. They should stop working so hard and find time for themselves. They should learn to make self-sacrifice and show love for other people. ## ♁ Lilith - Black Moon - Fascination and Denial

Lilith is a fictional point - the second empty focal point of elliptical orbit of the Moon around the Earth.

In mythology, Lilith refused to submit to Adam, rebelled against the connection between Adam and Eve, decided to escape from the world of people and made a connection with Satan.

In astrology, Lilith symbolises either fascination or refusal of topics with which she is connected with. Both, the fascination or the rejection of the given topics, can eventually engulf the person and take him "away" from the human world.

## ♄ Chiron - Wounded Healer, inner teacher

Chiron is an asteroid between Saturn and Uranus. Its orbit is very unusual and represents a bridge between material and spiritual worlds.

According to mythology, Chiron was a great healer, wise teacher and one of the immortal Centaurs. Unfortunately, he was "deadly" injured by a poisonous arrow by Heracles, his favourite disciple. He was suffering in great pain but he could not die. Finally, he gave up his immortality for the benefit of Prometheus who was also suffering, and Chiron was sent to the underworld. In the underworld Zeus had mercy for him and he raised him to the heaven.

In astrology, Chiron symbolises our unhealable injuries and incurable trauma. However, if a person, instead of drowning in his own trauma, is able to accept the trauma and help others who are also suffering, and accept that suffering is part of life, then Chiron may be the key to wisdom, or even to some sort of "Initiation Gate".

### Chiron in ♊ Gemini

Without success, these people keep trying to explain to other what they wanted to say, what they said and what they meant by it. They either believe that nobody listens to them, or that no matter how hard they try, others cannot understand them or do not want to understand them. The more they try to correct this misunderstanding, the more this sense of misunderstanding that they can never overcome hurts them.

### Chiron in the 9th House

## Main aspects

### ☼ - Sun Sextile Moon (0°19', Applying)

Emotions and feelings of the Moon are in harmony with ego and individuality of the Sun. This contributes to balance, relaxation and inner peace. This aspect also greatly increases the chance to find success and satisfaction in life. Relationships with the opposite sex are mostly balanced and harmonious.

### ☼ - Sun Sextile Mars (2°52', Separating)

Harmonious aspects give these people the desire to set objectives and the ability to reach their goals. Assertivity, energy, competitiveness, impatience and readiness are all the typical manifestations of these aspects.

### ☼ - Sun Sextile Saturn (1°58', Separating)

This harmonious aspect give these people the ability to work hard and take on responsibility at work, so they are usually very responsible. However, they often have low self-concept and tendencies to be too hard on themselves.

✳ - **Sun Sextile Uranus** (2°20', Separating)

This harmonious aspect brings conventionality and independence. It also gives these people creative dynamics and independent creativity. They like to work on projects that benefit their society; they are idealistic, progressive, intuitive and original. They have the need to be different and they want to show their uniqueness. They want to be teachers, mentors and examples to others.

△ - **Moon Trine Mars** (2°32', Separating)

This harmonious aspect create constructive and practical people. They are able to solve problems at home easily because they are good willing and prepared to compromise. They are open and they express themselves with seriousness. They are great hosts.

♃ - **Moon Conjunction Jupiter** (5°22', Separating)

This conjunction can manifest itself in two different ways: These people can either be generous, kind and good-natured individuals who are great hosts, or they can be demanding people who require lot of luxury, care and love. They also like long journeys and they want to have large families. These introverts often lead religious life and spend lot of time contemplating. They can be selfish when they try to promote their interests and they like studying and living abroad.

△ - **Moon Trine Saturn** (1°38', Separating)

This harmonious aspect gives people emotional stability. In their home environment they often do things in a way they think is right. They are reliable, stable and helpful. However, sometimes they may be pedant.

△ - **Moon Trine Uranus** (2°00', Separating)

This harmonious aspect brings people the need for considerable emotional independence and freedom in the family environment. These people often lead unconventional life and they do not like to yield to the will of others. They feel separated from society (complex of separation). They often experience stormy emotions and mood swings.

△ - **Moon Trine Neptune** (7°15', Applying)

This aspect gives people the need to search for something transcendental, and this is often the reason why these people tend to be religious or join various esoteric movements. These people are self-sacrificing and other people often take advantage of them. Their home is quite untidy. This conjunction also gives people a combination of perceptiveness and sensitivity, and the ability to accept the world of higher vibrations. This aspect gives artists great inspiration.

✳ - **Mercury Sextile Venus** (1°49', Separating)

This harmonious aspect gives people balance, charming manners and wisdom. These people have ideal qualities for educating others and for communication in general. In relationships they are pleasant and sensitive.

♁ - **Mercury Square Pluto** (0°16', Applying)

This aspect affects thinking in such a way that these people are overly dominated by their opinions and instincts. This results in biased thinking. These people study sporadically, but when they do, they put all their energy into it and consequently they become very exhausted. When they search for truth they are convinced of their opinions and they do not consider practical aspects much. They often use all the information and intelligence they have into manipulating others. However, they are often unaware of it.

♁ - **Venus Square Neptune** (5°08', Separating)

This aspect causes considerable romantic feelings that complicate life and put these people into intricate situations. They often give priority to their own fantasies over reality. Esoteric activities sometimes become more important to them than the reality and take away considerable amounts of energy from the relationship. These people should try to be more rational and have "thick skin". They are usually very lazy. For artists, this aspect brings inspiration, creativity, imagination, and very good taste.

△ - **Mars Trine Jupiter** (2°49', Separating)

This harmonious aspect gives people energy and activity. People with this aspect need movement, whether in the form of active sport or tourism. They are also eager for new information so they like to participate in various courses, seminars and training sessions.

♂ - **Mars Conjunction Saturn** (0°54', Applying)

This conjunction gives people reliability, decency and the ability to work without getting tired. They usually also have excellent organisational skills. They like stability and security. They do not like to take risks. They can easily deal with challenges and obstacles.

♄ - **Mars Conjunction Uranus** (0°31', Applying)

This conjunction gives people independence, individualism and, as is the tradition when the aspect is related to Uranus, inventiveness and the desire to discover new things and insights. Routine would kill these people. They like responsibility for their activities and they prefer solving problems on their own. This conjunction is very risky because both planets are impulsive. These people like to be very active and they like extreme experience. They are often hyperactive.

♃ - **Jupiter Trine Saturn** (3°43', Applying)

This harmonious aspect is extremely positive - it gives these people good foundation, stability and balance, and enables them to fully develop.

♃ - **Jupiter Trine Uranus** (3°21', Applying)

This harmonious aspect gives people independence - in opinions, business, thinking and speech, depending on in which house the planets are located. This aspect also gives people idealism, but in a positive sense. These people are very reflective. They want to give others the impression that they are strong and powerful and that they want to exercise their rights.

♄ - **Saturn Conjunction Uranus** (0°22', Separating)

This conjunction gives people determination, originality, the ability to work hard, and the ability to find new solutions to all problems. These people have democratic ideals but they are often too authoritative.

♆ - **Neptune Sextile Pluto** (3°02', Applying)

This harmonious aspect is long-lasting and it affects peace-making attitudes. In connection with other aspects it further enhances peace-building and transformative actions on global scale.

## Other aspects

♁ - **Ascendant Square Mars** (5°13', Applying)

The positive thing about this aspect is that it gives people assertiveness, abundant energy and physical resilience. The negative side of this aspect is that these people may be impatient and they are susceptible to infections and minor injuries.

♁ - **Ascendant Square Saturn** (6°08', Applying)

The positive thing about this aspect is that these people are prudent and honest. The negative side of this aspect is that they can feel obstructions and difficulties in gaining popularity among people. They also get tired easily and they may suffer from frequent colds and attacks of rheumatism.

♁ - **Ascendant Square Uranus** (5°45', Applying)

The positive thing about this aspect is that it gives people skilful and original behaviour. The negative side of this aspect is that it gives people desire to surprise and shock others at any cost.

♁ - **Ascendant Opposition Node** (0°05', Separating)

♆ - **MC Sextile Jupiter** (3°00', Applying)

♁ - **MC Opposition Uranus** (6°21', Applying)

The positive thing about this aspect is that it gives people skilful and original behaviour that helps them achieve their goals. The negative side of this aspect is that it may cause bouts of rebellion that can be responsible for changes in their social status.

♁ - **MC Square Node** (0°30', Applying)

♁ - **Node Square Mars** (5°19', Separating)

#### ☐ - **Node Square Saturn** (6°13', Separating)

#### ☐ - **Node Square Uranus** (5°51', Separating)

The positive thing about this aspect is that it gives people desire to search for new and original ways to deal with their life challenges. The development of their individuality is in harmony with the focal point of their life.

The negative side of this aspect is that these people want to live the way they like and according to their own rules. They feel a constant painful gap between their need for independence and freedom and the challenges they face in their lives. It is very difficult for them to concentrate on what is really important.

### Declination aspects - Parallels and Contra-Parallels

Parallels and Contra-Parallels are aspects, which refer to degrees of declination above or below the celestial equator.

- Parallel is similar to a conjunction, but usually provides benefits.
- Contra-Parallel is said to be similar to the opposition, but weaker.

Note: The following parallel and contra-parallel interpretations are the same as the interpretations used for the conjunction and opposition.

#### ☿ - **Sun Contra-Parallel Jupiter** (1°09')

This aspect creates people who are idealistic and this is the reason why they often support various dubious movements and clubs. People with this aspect are often willing to make great sacrifices. They are overly optimistic, they like to travel, and they do not like commitment.

#### ☾ - **Moon Contra-Parallel Mercury** (0°48')

They may have problems in the emotional area and be inclined to gossip. They are very intelligent but they often use their intelligence to deceive people by lying. They even tend to deceive themselves and they often start believing their "truths" themselves.

#### ♂ - **Mars Parallel Uranus** (0°01')

This conjunction gives people independence, individualism and, as is the tradition when the aspect is related to Uranus, inventiveness and the desire to discover new things and insights. Routine would kill these people. They like responsibility for their activities and they prefer solving problems on their own. This conjunction is very risky because both planets are impulsive. These people like to be very active and they like extreme experience. They are often hyperactive.

#### ♄ - **Saturn Parallel Neptune** (0°11')

It is necessary to distinguish which of the two planets is dominant in this conjunction. If Saturn is dominant, then the person is able to keep his imagination under control and use it constructively to fulfill his dreams. However, if Neptune is dominant, then the fantasy is too vivid, and these people fail to fulfill their fantasies and they become frustrated. They start living in their fantasy world and they become practically useless. The positive thing about this aspect is that it gives people skilful and original behaviour that helps them achieve their goals. The negative side of this aspect is that it may cause bouts of rebellion that can be responsible for changes in their social status.

♆ - **MC Contra-Parallel Neptune** (1°09')

The positive thing about this aspect is that it gives people intuition that helps them find their life path. The negative side of this aspect is that these people may lose their life direction because they are not clearly aware of their real abilities.
