

## 1st house - Ascendant (ASC)

### Physical personality

Ascendant (ASC) - Symbolises basic personality traits such as physical appearance, temperament, behaviour, relationship to life and the first impression the person gives.

### Ascendant in Gemini (Gemini ruler is Mercury)

Gemini Ascendant is associated with curiosity and interest in how things work. Versatility and adaptability are your advantages, but these traits can lead to fragmentation of interests. These people can do everything, but they do not excel in anything. They do not like to choose only one thing if they have more options. Their mission is to disseminate information. If the horoscope has a water or earth character, then this person needs to develop analytical and objective thinking. ### The ruler of the Ascendant - Mercury

## 10th house - Medium Coeli (MC)

### Career, prestige and reputation

Medium Coeli (MC) - Symbolises social status, career, reputation, honours, fame, success, authoritative personality, father.

### 10th house in Pisces (Pisces ruler is Neptune)

People with Pisces on the tenth house cusp often follow a career in church, medicine, theatre or other areas associated with spirituality and esoterism. These people are perceptive and enthusiastic but they lack stability. When the tenth house is occupied with several star signs then they may want to go on long journeys on sea. These people have an advanced spirit, but they are also unrealistic dreamers.

### The ruler of the 10th House (Neptune) in the 6th House

Career of these people is related to services and healthy living. These people often become doctors, surgeons, accountants, etc.

- **Planets** describe a certain process of what is happening - eg. Mars fights, Saturn limits, Jupiter expands..
- **Sign** in which the planet is located determines how the planet is manifesting itself, for example Mars may manifest itself in a way Aries would behave (vigorously and irritably) or in the manner of Taurus (more slowly, gradually and consistently)
- **Houses** show special areas of everyday life, in which all this takes place. Location in a house shows whether, for example Mars manifests in relationships (7th house), employment (6th house), family (4th house) or elsewhere.

**Hint:**Planets show us **what** is happening;Signs show us **how** it is hapenning;Houses show us **where** it is happening.

☉ **Sun** - Self, individuality, personality

The Sun symbolises a personal identity. It shows us areas where the person should learn to be independent, where he should fulfill his potential, differentiate himself from others and shine. The position of the Sun may tell us which profession would best suit the character of a person.

**Sun in ♑ Capricorn**

Capricorn sign is ruled by the planet Saturn, which gives people born under this sign peace, patience, perseverance and ambition. These people are able to put maximum effort into work they have chosen to do or which they were told to do. They are friendly and cheerful people, but in their essence they are serious and responsible, and everything they do is based on these attitudes. more ->

**Sun in the 8th House**

### ♿ Mercury - Thinking, communication, intellect, learning

Mercury is the planet that brings us interest in intellectual things, about teaching and learning. It also indicates into what depth we want to study things. It gives us natural intelligence and the ability to analyse and reproduce.

### Mercury in ♒ Aquarius

People with Mercury in Aquarius do not care what they write as long as they can write. These people learn foreign languages easily and they flirt with abstract ideas, scientific predictions and their intuition. Venus symbolises attractivity. Sign in which Venus is tells us what we are attracted to and this enables us to give or receive love and affection, beauty and happiness, values and principles. The negative side is that it represents weakness and shallowness.

### Venus in ♓ Pisces

Venus in Pisces gains importance because love and beauty can be fully expressed in this sensitive, imaginative, and compassionate sign. However, in order to reach the highest point, we must sometimes fall to the lowest point. These people must learn how to best express their universal sense of love, otherwise they will be condemned to excessive vulnerability and sensitivity, and their worrying nature will be misused. Mars symbolises the need to get what we want. This means our driving force which includes sex drive, initiative and courage. Mars tells us about our desires, sensuality, courage and will. It also tells us about how we are able to overcome obstacles and how active we are.

**Mars in ♏ Scorpio**

People with Mars in Scorpio are pleased to be able to hide their power and show it to the world at the right moment. They have a strong sense of survival and sexuality, and they are well aware of how these two instincts intertwine. Jupiter symbolises growth, expansion, laws, faith and ethics that guide it. It represents a sense for development and support, which can lead to opportunities, wealth and faith. However, if Jupiter is damaged, the person becomes immoral and extremist.

**Jupiter in ♎ Libra**

Uranus is the power of awakening, which often means that there will be some disruption and change. Events under the influence of Uranus are unexpected or unpredictable, forcing us to do things in a new way and face the truth about this or that issue.

#### Uranus in ♎ Libra

*(Note: Uranus is a slow transpersonal planet and may remain in a single sign for up to many years. The description of Uranus in Libra is therefore valid for the entire generation of people and is very general. The characteristic of the personality is in the description of Uranus in the 4th house.)*

Uranus in Libra brings sudden and intense energy into traditional desire for harmony and tranquillity. People with Uranus in this position do not accept traditional forms of relationships, in love or other interpersonal relationships. They can bring new elements into politics and art.

#### Uranus in the 4th House

Uranus in the fourth house creates instability in the home or in the family background. It suggests the possibility of unexpected changes and disruptions in the household. These people are looking for liberation from bonds with their home or they long for freedom at least in their privacy. Neptune is called the Lord of the Invisible Empire, which is a mysterious name of a mysterious planet. Perhaps we could describe it as a dimension of life that cannot be experienced by our five senses and we can only understand and perceive it in our imagination.

#### Neptune in ♏ Scorpio

The description of Neptune in Scorpio is therefore valid for the entire generation of people and is very general. The characteristic of the personality is in the description of Neptune in the 6th house.)*

Neptune in Scorpio gives people occult abilities and the desire to discover secret spiritual doctrines. These people have a great creative potential, but it is hidden and they are not aware of it. It may be difficult to activate this potential.

**Neptune in the 6th House**

Neptune in the sixth house suggests a connection with the work environment, the need to provide services and also with health. These people may have the spiritual urge to help others. They may have illusions about their job and have somewhat grandiose attitude towards their job. They often have difficulties fulfilling their everyday duties and with small things. They are not good organizers and they are not very practical. They have to pay attention to their health.

Pluto is the planet of death and rebirth. It is the end of all things, it is the Judgment Day. It can give rise to obsessions or convictions. On the dark end of its spectrum it can manifest as "succumbing to the urge," or it can create an individual who has the ability to get to the core of things, destroy negative things and bring on healing and transformation.

**Pluto in ♍ Virgo**

*(Note: Pluto is a slow transpersonal planet and may remain in a single sign for up to many years. The description of Pluto in Virgo is therefore valid for the entire generation of people and is very general. The characteristic of the personality is in the description of Pluto in the 4th house.)*

People with Pluto in Virgo are accurate and methodical. If the planet is damaged, they may start looking for faults and become too strict about adherence to rules. They can achieve transformation by analysing.

**Pluto in the 4th House**

Pluto in the fourth house creates tension at home. These people will have the tendency to be domineering towards their friends and relatives. In such a home environment there may be a struggle for power among family members. These people have a strong bond with their home or country. In some cases, they will be interested in science or jobs that deal with their country or the world.

The Lunar Nodes aren't planets, but rather astrology mathematical points, that are directly opposite each other in the chart. It is said, that your life purpose is encoded between them - in the line between North Node and South Node. The South Node indicates your comfort zone, your habitual place, while your North Node shows life lessons and what you're striving for in this lifetime. Both Lunar Nodes are almost always retrograde.

**North Node (Mean) in ♈ Aries** - South Node in Libra

North Node in Aries brings the conflict between the need for self-development and the pursuit of harmony; mental balance and the ability to adapt in a relationship; tension between giving and receiving.

These people need to develop the courage to step out of old relationship habits and create the right relationship with themselves. They need to do what they think is right. They should concentrate on developing their independence and self-confidence. They should be willing to deal with conflicts and accept losses in relationships.

Beware of over-adaptability and inclination to help everyone, even if it is against their own needs.

**North Node (Mean) in the 10th House** - South Node in the 4th House

North Node in the tenth house brings the conflict between personal life, public career and spiritual self-awareness. These people need to learn to get out of their fragile shells. They need to grow up, develop discipline, consistency and be more

outspoken. They should get rid of emotional addictions and learn not to emphasize their own needs.

Beware of emotional dependence and being in the position of a hurt child who is looking for the culprits of his failures. Beware of clinging to affection and protection instead of finding the courage to acknowledge the harsh reality.

#### ♆ **Lilith** - Black Moon - Fascination and Denial

Lilith is a fictional point - the second empty focal point of elliptical orbit of the Moon around the Earth.

In mythology, Lilith refused to submit to Adam, rebelled against the connection between Adam and Eve, decided to escape from the world of people and made a connection with Satan.

In astrology, Lilith symbolises either fascination or refusal of topics with which she is connected with. Both, the fascination or the rejection of the given topics, can eventually engulf the person and take him "away" from the human world.

#### Lilith (Mean) in ♊ Gemini

Ambiguous communication, fascination with ambiguity and shadows, the search for identity.

These people live in the world of thoughts that are completely free and subject to the constant process of change. Lilith in Gemini emphasises all this more intensely and these people are virtually unstoppable. They have a great desire for knowledge and information. They do not take anything seriously because they think that everything can be changed. They tend to change information and then pass this modified information on. They do not like to live in one place for too long and they make friends easily. They especially like to meet non-conformist, unusual people.

Beware of asthma and injuries of lungs, arms, hands and shoulders.

#### Lilith (Mean) in the 12th House

Tendency to become a victim; cult of mystery; exploration of the suffering of others.



#### ♏ **Chiron** - Wounded Healer, inner teacher

Chiron is an asteroid between Saturn and Uranus. Its orbit is very unusual and represents a bridge between material and spiritual worlds.

According to mythology, Chiron was a great healer, wise teacher and one of the immortal Centaurs. Unfortunately, he was "deadly" injured by a poisonous arrow by Heracles, his favourite disciple. He was suffering in great pain but he could not die. Finally, he gave up his immortality for the benefit of Prometheus who was also suffering, and Chiron was sent to the underworld. In the underworld Zeus had mercy for him and he raised him to the heaven.

In astrology, Chiron symbolises our unhealable injuries and incurable trauma. However, if a person, instead of drowning in his own trauma, is able to accept the trauma and help others who are also suffering, and accept that suffering is part of life, then Chiron may be the key to wisdom, or even to some sort of "Initiation Gate".

#### Chiron in ♓ Pisces

There people believe that the world is a place of great suffering and that there is physical and moral misery, illness, violence and injustice all around us. Even sympathy with suffering people can become unhealable injury because this suffering never ends.

These people can react with disgust and resignation, or on contrary, by helping others because by helping others these people can also heal their own irreparable injury.

#### Chiron in the 10th House

No matter how hard these people try, they fail to achieve the social status that you believe they deserve. While they work so hard for public well-being, others enjoy their place under the Sun. These people often do a lot for the general public, and instead of acknowledgement they face persecution. This injury never stops hurting and never heals completely even when things are corrected later on.

## Main aspects

### ☐ - **Sun Square Moon** (3°18', Separating)

There is a tension between emotions and feelings of the Moon and the ego and individuality of the Sun. This can cause conflicts, especially in relationships between close family members - parents and children. Emotions of people with this aspect can hamper their development or they may feel emotionally insecure. These people find it hard to understand people of the opposite sex.

### ☐ - **Sun Square Saturn** (2°20', Separating)

This aspect creates two groups of people. People in the first group tend to give up when they encounter problems. When people in the second group encounter problems they get stimulated by them and perform better. These people often have lower self-esteem that can be improved by good work.

### △ - **Sun Trine Pluto** (3°35', Applying)

This harmonious aspect gives people decisiveness and good manners. However, these people are also stubborn and secretive. They have a tendency to influence others through effective manipulation at subconscious level. These people have excellent regenerative abilities and extremely strong will. They think that they are able to achieve anything they want and they usually get it at any cost.

### ♁ - **Moon Opposition Saturn** (5°39', Separating)

This aspect creates people who are unable to express their feelings and prefer to hide behind a mask they create. They need a stable home where they can feel safe. In their family life they tend to artificially create too many duties. They are inclined to depressions.

### ☐ - **Mercury Square Mars** (2°55', Separating)

This aspect gives people impatience and they are often quarrelsome. They have strong personalities so they usually do not have good relationships with others. They are good leaders. ### △ - **Ascendant Trine Moon** (0°56', Separating)

The positive thing about this aspect is that it gives people adaptability and mental balance.

### ☐ - **Ascendant Square Pluto** (0°39', Separating)

The positive thing about this aspect is that it gives people independent, sometimes even extreme behaviour and the ability to physically and mentally regenerate. The negative thing about this aspect is that these people do not

realise what impression they are making on others and they often cause themselves harm because of it.

♁ - **MC Conjunction Venus** (3°06', Applying)

The positive thing about this aspect is that these people are popular at work. The negative side of this aspect is that they tend to be jealous and dissatisfied in their work environment.

♂ - **MC Trine Mars** (2°35', Applying)

The positive thing about this aspect is that it gives people fighting spirit and lot of energy that helps them achieve success at work.

♁ - **Node Opposition Jupiter** (1°53', Separating)

The positive thing about this aspect is that these people are confident in their abilities and this helps them overcome challenges in life. Their life challenges are often connected with profound sensory experience and it gives people luck on their life journey.

Parallels and Contra-Parallels are aspects, which refer to degrees of declination above or below the celestial equator.

- Parallel is similar to a conjunction, but usually provides benefits.
- Contra-Parallel is said to be similar to the opposition, but weaker.

Note: The following parallel and contra-parallel interpretations are the same as the interpretations used for the conjunction and opposition.
