

Interpretations - Ascendant, Medium Coeli, House rulers

Before reading the following interpretation done by a computer it is good to note that any planet position or aspect mentioned in your horoscope may be insignificant. You should always remember the rule:

Nothing should be evaluated separately, things should always be considered in a broader context and with regard to other planet positions and aspects of the horoscope.



1st house - Ascendant (ASC)

Physical personality

Ascendant (ASC) - Symbolises basic personality traits such as physical appearance, temperament, behaviour, relationship to life and the first impression the person gives.

Ascendant in Taurus (Taurus ruler is Venus)

People who have Taurus Ascendant enter life slowly and relentlessly. They do not rush. They make plans, build and work systematically in order to achieve their goal. However, they might become lazy, or they want things to stay the same even though they have no longer purpose or meaning. ... [more ->](#)

The ruler of the Ascendant - Venus

These people tend to act in accordance with their feelings, love, or passions. They like luxury, wealth and beauty. They do not like living alone and they need to be accepted by other people. They often take the path of the least resistance. They are good companions; they like good food and drinks.

The ruler of the Ascendant (Venus) in Aquarius

These people acts suddenly and unexpectedly while they are generating friendship and sympathy of other people. They are able to create romantically and impulsively. They are able to predict the future. They behave according to their predictions or they are pleased with their predictions. Often they try to test themselves in order to find out what they actually believe in.

Medium Coeli (MC) - Symbolises social status, career, reputation, honours, fame, success, authoritative personality, father.

10th house in Capricorn (Capricorn ruler is Saturn)

People with Capricorn on the tenth house cusp have a great desire for career growth and they are likely to become scientists or work in education, libraries, construction or politics. Their career growth is gradual and stable. Capricorn on the tenth house in cusp brings success later in life.

The ruler of the 10th House (Saturn) in the 12th House

These people often have occupations that involve secrets or are not visible. Great deal of their professional activity takes place behind the scenes and not many people see what they do - they are often writers, hospital directors, film directors, producers, owners of some kind of showbusiness etc.

Interpretations - Planets in Signs, Planets in Houses

- **Planets** describe a certain process of what is happening - eg. Mars fights, Saturn limits, Jupiter expands..
- **Sign** in which the planet is located determines how the planet is manifesting itself, for example Mars may manifest itself in a way Aries would behave (vigorously and irritably) or in the manner of Taurus (more slowly, gradually and consistently)
- **Houses** show special areas of everyday life, in which all this takes place. Location in a house shows whether, for example Mars manifests in relationships (7th house), employment (6th house), family (4th house) or elsewhere.

Hint:

Planets show us **what** is happening;
Signs show us **how** it is happening;
Houses show us **where** it is happening.

Planets:

☉ **Sun** - Self, individuality, personality

The Sun symbolises a personal identity. It shows us areas where the person should learn to be independent, where he should fulfill his potential, differentiate himself from others and shine. The position of the Sun may tell us which profession would best suit the character of a person.

Sun in ♋ Pisces

People born under the sign of Pisces are just like people born under the sign of Aquarius influenced by two planets. Jupiter gives them sense for justice, social conscience and willingness to help others, while Neptune both helps them and complicates their life. Neptune gives them imagination, creativity and emotionality, but it also gives them hypersensitivity and dreaminess that leads to passivity, indecision and excessive sensitivity. more ->

Sun in the 12th House

The Sun in the twelfth house indicates a desire for perfection. These people usually do not get full recognition for their abilities and efforts, but they do not mind. They are satisfied with their simple, quiet life in solitude. If they become managers, they will do their job inconspicuously and with modesty. Their services to other people are an area in which they are likely to achieve recognition and satisfaction. These people are usually interested in psychology and research of psychological phenomena. ☾ **Moon** - Emotions, instincts, roots, mother

Place in the horoscope where the Moon is tells us what gives the person a sense of security, and where to find it. It describes how sensitive we are and how we instinctively interact with our surroundings. The Moon also tells us about our childhood and our experiences with our mother.

Mercury is the planet that brings us interest in intellectual things, about teaching and learning. It also indicates into what depth we want to study things. It gives us natural intelligence and the ability to analyse and reproduce.

Mercury in ♒ Aquarius

People with Mercury in Aquarius do not care what they write as long as they can write. These people learn foreign languages easily and they flirt with abstract ideas, scientific predictions and their intuition. Their mind goes through processes that are "connected" to the so-called Universal Mind, so they perceive things that other people find highly unlikely. Venus symbolises attractivity. Sign in which Venus is tells us what we are attracted to and this enables us to give or receive love and affection, beauty and happiness, values and principles. The negative side is that it represents weakness and shallowness.

Venus in ♒ Aquarius

People with Venus in Aquarius have an open and experimental approach to relationships and art. On the one hand, it can be both relaxing and stimulating because it lets other people relax and be themselves. But on the other hand it may be harder to understand their feelings because their style may be disturbing, shocking or weird. They want to satisfy all types of people with their liberal attitude but if they do not adhere to some moral code, their relationships will end when their partner finds out that their broad-mindedness and free spirit are only manifestations of hidden objections. Jupiter in ♐ Sagittarius

Saturn is our strict teacher who is able to ruthlessly examine our maturity. However, it is not only the despot, but also the archetype of the sage who uses pain as a means to get our attention on what we should focus on and what we should continue to develop.

Saturn in ♓ Pisces

People with Saturn in Pisces have to strike a balance between the need to ignore the demands of their own life and the need to take care of other people's problems. In order to find the golden middle way between these extremes, sooner or later they will have to find a way to call the wisdom of the Ancient Soul within themselves. Uranus in ♑ Capricorn

(Note: Uranus is a slow transpersonal planet and may remain in a single sign for up to many years. The description of Uranus in Capricorn is therefore valid for the entire generation of people and is very general. The characteristic of the personality is in the description of Uranus in the 10th house.)

Uranus in Capricorn intensifies some controversial features of people born under the sign of Capricorn, for example their ability to control others, but it also gives them the tendency to rebel against order and authority. They will tend to introduce new orders and they may also try to control politics. It will increase the coldness of people born in this sign. These people have a fairly good chance to introduce and enforce new management methods.

Uranus in the 10th House

Uranus in the tenth house suggests instability in career and in the way public perceives actions of these people. These people have unusual approach towards their career, so they need to work independently or have their own business, otherwise they will not get on well with their boss. They will get their new ideas unexpectedly and suddenly. They know immediately how to get something done and they will try to do it. They are not afraid to make decisions and act. Neptune is called the Lord of the Invisible Empire, which is a mysterious name of a mysterious planet. Perhaps we could describe it as a dimension of life that cannot be experienced by our five senses and we can only understand and perceive it in our imagination.

Neptune in ♑ Capricorn

(Note: Neptune is a slow transpersonal planet and may remain in a single sign for up to many years. The description of Neptune in Capricorn is therefore valid for the entire generation of people and is very general. The characteristic of the personality is in the description of Neptune in the 10th house.)

Neptune in Capricorn gives people determination and the ability to concentrate. However, it can ruin their typical Capricorn rationality. This position somewhat shatters their natural desire for perfection, but it gives people desire to achieve spiritual goals.

Neptune in the 10th House

Neptune in the tenth house brings spiritual impulses in the areas of employment and public recognition. It produces a certain amount of confusion and these people may have difficulties in finding the right job. These people are often not who they seem to be and the way they act may contradict their true personality. They have either too much ambition or they do not get the recognition for their efforts they deserve.

♇ Pluto - Transformation, regeneration, power

Pluto is the planet of death and rebirth. It is the end of all things, it is the Judgment Day. It can give rise to obsessions or convictions. On the dark end of its spectrum it can manifest as "succumbing to the urge," or it can create an individual who has the ability to get to the core of things, destroy negative things and bring on healing and transformation.

Pluto in ♐ Sagittarius

(Note: Pluto is a slow transpersonal planet and may remain in a single sign for up to many years. The description of Pluto in Sagittarius is therefore valid for the entire generation of people and is very general. The characteristic of the personality is in the description of Pluto in the 7th house.)

People with Pluto in Sagittarius are understanding and philosophical. Personal transformation can occur especially through philosophical searching. Pluto in this position strengthens their innate (not learnt) religious consciousness and feeling. We can expect them to create a new spiritual or mystical direction, and attempts to merge existing religions and churches.

Pluto in the 7th House

Pluto in the seventh house creates attitudes that lead to deep and complicated relationships. It is likely that their life will be substantially changed by marriage or other personal relationships. Their partner could be stubborn and this may lead to serious conflicts. These people will probably have a strongly developed sense of justice.

♋ Lunar Nodes - North Node and South Node

The Lunar Nodes aren't planets, but rather astrology mathematical points, that are directly opposite each other in the chart. It is said, that your life purpose is encoded between them - in the line between North Node and South Node. The South Node indicates your comfort zone, your habitual place, while your North Node shows life lessons and what you're striving for in this lifetime. Both Lunar Nodes are almost always retrograde.

North Node (Mean) in ♏ Scorpio - South Node in Taurus
North Node in Scorpio brings the conflict between spiritual and material property, between acknowledgement of transience and the desire to own something.

These people need to accept transience and to recognize that death is a great teacher. They should not base their life on false material values and build on them. They should explore spiritual values instead. They should stop avoiding conflicts and they should not stay in comfortable sterility.

Beware of greed and clinging to material assets that are proven and secure. Actual values lie deeper.

North Node (Mean) in the 7th House - South Node in the 1st House

North Node in the seventh house brings the conflict between the pursuit of harmony, balance and adjustment in a relationship on the one hand, and self-awareness and self-development on the other.

These people need to learn to meet the needs of others. They have to develop understanding, thoughtfulness and sensitivity in a relationship. They need to be more adaptable and stop asking for self-sacrifice from others.

Beware of egocentrism and self-indulgence for fear of losing independence.

♁ Lilith - Black Moon - Fascination and Denial

Lilith is a fictional point - the second empty focal point of elliptical orbit of the Moon around the Earth.

In mythology, Lilith refused to submit to Adam, rebelled against the connection between Adam and Eve, decided to escape from the world of people and made a connection with Satan.

In astrology, Lilith symbolises either fascination or refusal of topics with which she is connected with. Both, the fascination or the rejection of the given topics, can eventually engulf the person and take him "away" from the human world.

Lilith (Mean) in ♊ Gemini

Ambiguous communication, fascination with ambiguity and shadows, the search for identity.

These people live in the world of thoughts that are completely free and subject to the constant process of change. Lilith in Gemini emphasises all this more intensely and these people are virtually unstoppable. They have a great desire for knowledge and information. They do not take anything seriously because they think that everything can be changed. They tend to change information and then pass this modified information on. They do not like to live in one place for too long and they make friends easily. They especially like to meet non-conformist, unusual people.

Beware of asthma and injuries of lungs, arms, hands and shoulders.

Lilith (Mean) in the 2nd House

Clear ambiguity between obsession and rejection of material goods.



♄ Chiron - Wounded Healer, inner teacher

Chiron is an asteroid between Saturn and Uranus. Its orbit is very unusual and represents a bridge between material and spiritual worlds.

According to mythology, Chiron was a great healer, wise teacher and one of the immortal Centaurs. Unfortunately, he was "deadly" injured by a poisonous arrow by Heracles, his favourite disciple. He was suffering in great pain but he could not die. Finally, he gave up his immortality for the benefit of Prometheus who was also suffering, and Chiron was sent to the underworld. In the underworld Zeus had mercy for him and he raised him to the

heaven.

In astrology, Chiron symbolises our unhealable injuries and incurable trauma. However, if a person, instead of drowning in his own trauma, is able to accept the trauma and help others who are also suffering, and accept that suffering is part of life, then Chiron may be the key to wisdom, or even to some sort of "Initiation Gate".

Chiron in ♍ Virgo

These people are sick all their life; their illnesses are not too serious, but they are chronic and it seems that they cannot be cured, especially when both medical professionals and traditional healers cannot give the correct diagnosis. It is as if these people took all the illness of others on themselves and had no choice but to learn to live with their health problems and keep searching for new ways to cure them or at least to alleviate the symptoms. But there is always the fear that once one illness is cured, another, more serious illness will suddenly appear.

Chiron in the 6th House

These people are sick all their life; their illnesses are not too serious, but they are chronic and it seems that they cannot be cured, especially when both medical professionals and traditional healers cannot give the correct diagnosis. Main aspects

☐ - Sun Square Jupiter (1°34', Applying)

This aspect creates people who are idealistic and this is the reason why they often support various dubious movements and clubs. People with this aspect are often willing to make great sacrifices. They are overly optimistic, they like to travel, and they do not like commitment.

♋ - Sun Conjunction Saturn (2°10', Applying)

This conjunction gives these people self-discipline. They like their life as it is and they do not like changes. These people often experience problems and difficulties but they have enough energy to overcome them and become stronger.

♌ - Moon Trine Mars (8°05', Applying)

This harmonious aspect creates constructive and practical people. They are able to solve problems at home easily because they are good willing and prepared to compromise. They are open and they express themselves with seriousness. They are great hosts.

♌ - Moon Trine Jupiter (6°11', Applying)

These people are extremely open, optimistic and generous. Thanks to these characteristics they are often successful and they radiate them on to others. They are idealists and they love to have a pleasant home. They are excellent students and they are successful in winning legal disputes.

♌ - Moon Trine Pluto (7°18', Separating)

This harmonious aspect brings very intense emotional life and these people deeply experience their emotions. They want to change their loved ones for the better and they often openly and clearly express their opinions even at the cost of conflicts and quarrels. These people experience their emotions very strongly and they express them openly. Even though they experience strong emotions, they do not have emotional outbursts. They use their feelings to control others. They have a very intense relationship with their mother.

♊ - Mercury Opposition Mars (0°23', Applying)

This aspect gives people impatience and they are often quarrelsome. They have strong personalities so they usually do not have good relationships with others. They are good leaders. Many reformers had this aspect. Their thinking is quick and practical, but they tend to persuade others about their truth and they are often arrogant.

♊ - Mercury Sextile Jupiter (1°31', Separating)

This harmonious aspect brings optimism, kindness and openness. These people are often great philosophers. However, they like to satisfy their mental interests even if they do not have the money for it. They like to travel and they do not stay long in one place.

♋ - Venus Conjunction Uranus (1°52', Separating)

This conjunction causes considerable emotional independence, which often becomes a priority need. These people do not like commitments and they often

hide their true feelings. If they feel that their independence is threatened, they become cold and distant. They often leave a relationship without an evident cause. They need a feeling of freedom in any relationship. If they feel free they can be faithful and pleasant. They are creative and interested in technologies. They are also artistic and they like modern art.

♁ - **Venus Conjunction Neptune** (6°03', Separating)

This conjunction increases sensitivity, a sense of romance and the ability to idealise a partner. These characteristics can be responsible for disappointments and mistakes. Their fantasies are closer to them than reality. However, if they are in a good relationship, they are faithful and devoted. They love fashion, art and photography. Transcendent, mysticism and magic sexually arouse women with this aspect. This aspect in men tells us about characteristics of his inner woman-anima and thus it also tells us about the personality of women that will be interested in him. For artists, this aspect brings inspiration, creativity, imagination, and a very good taste.

♁ - **Venus Sextile Pluto** (0°11', Separating)

This harmonious aspect gives people the ability to experience relationships very deeply. However, these people require the same from their partner, and this may give rise to problems and conflicts, especially if these requirements are not met by the partner. This aspect gives people talent for publicity in media. They often have many useful contacts that help them succeed. This aspect activates sexuality and sex appeal. In general, these people can experience their sexuality without unnecessary "adornments" and superstitions.

♂ - **Mars Trine Jupiter** (1°54', Applying)

This harmonious aspect gives people energy and activity. People with this aspect need movement, whether in the form of active sport or tourism. They are also eager for new information so they like to participate in various courses, seminars and training sessions.

♃ - **Jupiter Square Saturn** (0°36', Separating)

This aspect gives people somewhat contradictory possibilities and because of that they constantly have to decide whether to make important changes or take a risk and follow a good opportunity. If they manage to find a reasonable compromise, the result is often great.

♅ - **Uranus Conjunction Neptune** (4°10', Separating)

This conjunction is responsible for urge for changes. These people tend to change their lives and to interfere with political affairs that they are never satisfied with. If they are publicly engaged, then their reformist efforts have some chances to be successful, otherwise they live in discontent with the circumstances all their life. This conjunction gives people immense originality, intense creative abilities and innovative inspirations.

♅ - **Uranus Sextile Pluto** (1°41', Applying)

This harmonious aspect is responsible for the fact that these people feel inner duty to change things in their life and in their surroundings. Depending on the nature of the aspect, these people frequently achieve significant personal transformations. This harmonious aspect creates strong and original personalities with genius ideas that will impress wide circles of people throughout the society.

Other aspects

♁ - **Ascendant Square Venus** (0°43', Applying)

The positive thing about this aspect is that these people are charming, friendly and they want to please others. The negative side of this aspect is that they are a bit clumsy when they socialise with other people.

♁ - **Ascendant Square Uranus** (1°09', Separating)

The positive thing about this aspect is that it gives people skilful and original behaviour. The negative side of this aspect is that it gives people desire to surprise and shock others at any cost.

♁ - **Ascendant Square Neptune** (5°19', Separating)

The positive thing about this aspect is that these people are intuitive and understanding. The negative side of this aspect is that they are impetuous and they find it hard to adapt to new situations. They should stay away from alcohol.

♁ - **MC Sextile Sun** (3°34', Separating)

This aspect indicates the ability to succeed using own means or with the help of others.

♁ - **MC Square Moon** (8°11', Separating)

This aspect can bring instability in professional life and these people often have unstable professions.

✱ - **MC Sextile Saturn** (1°24', Separating)

The positive thing about this aspect is that these people are persistent and honest when they are pursuing their goals.

Δ - **Node Trine Sun** (4°01', Separating)

This aspect brings great combination of life energy and life focus. The zodiac sign is very helpful and useful. However, it can eventually become an expression of convenience and missed chances.

Δ - **Node Trine Saturn** (6°12', Separating)

The positive thing about this aspect is that these people are focused on overcoming challenges in their life. They are consistent, aware of their responsibilities, and they walk tirelessly along their life path. They have high standards for themselves and they set ambitious goals. They are able to overcome their limits.

Declination aspects - Parallels and Contra-Parallels

Parallels and Contra-Parallels are aspects, which refer to degrees of declination above or below the celestial equator.

- Parallel is similar to a conjunction, but usually provides benefits.
- Contra-Parallel is said to be similar to the opposition, but weaker.

Note: The following parallel and contra-parallel interpretations are the same as the interpretations used for the conjunction and opposition.

|| - **Sun Parallel Saturn** (0°47')

This conjunction gives these people self-discipline. They like their life as it is and they do not like changes. These people often experience problems and difficulties but they have enough energy to overcome them and become stronger.

|| - **Sun Parallel Pluto** (0°01')

This conjunction is a deeply acting aspect that may bring unexpected and significant changes. These people often try to change their personality; spiritual study and professional psychoanalysis are great methods to use for this purpose. They have a tendency to influence others through effective manipulation at subconscious level. This conjunction is the aspect of secret and consciously concealed power. These people have a great will and desire to succeed. A paternal model plays a significant role here, but it is badly accepted because these people are authoritative and they practically do not accept any other authority, including the authority of their father.

⚡ - **Venus Contra-Parallel Mars** (0°54')

This aspect is similar to conjunction but these people get offended more easily and their emotions are unbalanced – their friends can quickly become their enemies. They are very impulsive and they often want impossible things from their partners. They are easily filled with enthusiasm about something but they lose their interest very quickly.

⚡ - **Mars Contra-Parallel Uranus** (0°50')

This aspect is responsible for people who are very eccentric, individualistic and sometimes even pathologically independent. They admire marginal religions or marginal political groups, but they are usually unable to get involved in these groups because they are very restless and unstable. However, if they develop their practical skill they can successfully complete their plans. They often have mood swings and they want considerable changes to the established order. They long for freedom and they are able to sacrifice anything for it.

⚡ - **Mars Contra-Parallel Neptune** (0°36')

This aspect is great for mysticism and it reinforces imagination and fantasy which these people often prefer to reality. Their practical approach to life is also greatly suppressed. They often combine feverish activities in order to promote themselves through illusions of their unrealistic ideals and fantasies. These people are often chaotic.

|| - **Jupiter Parallel Uranus** (0°49')

This conjunction gives people optimism - it gives them great ambitions and desires. However, the problem is that it is not easy to turn these ambitions into reality. They are adventurous and often also expansive. They are convinced of their exceptionalism and they believe in good future. This conjunction gives people independent assertivity and original manners.

|| - **Jupiter Parallel Neptune** (1°03')

This conjunction is an aspect that causes strong emotions. These people are very religious and idealistic, and they have a great desire for knowledge, travel and art. They can feel the energy people had when they were creating the cosmos.

|| - Saturn Parallel Pluto (0°46')

This conjunction brings especially strong self-control, ambitions, endurance and profound desire for change, transformation and development of personality. This aspect is great especially for Scorpios. People with this aspect find delight in deep thoughts and in intense self-reflection.

|| - Uranus Parallel Neptune (0°14')

This conjunction is responsible for urge for changes. These people tend to change their lives and to interfere with political affairs that they are never satisfied with. If they are publicly engaged, then their reformist efforts have some chances to be successful, otherwise they live in discontent with the circumstances all their life. This conjunction gives people immense originality, intense creative abilities and innovative inspirations.

|| - MC Parallel Jupiter (0°45')

The positive thing about this aspect is that these people believe in their ability to achieve success. This ability helps them grow. The negative side of this aspect is that they often overestimate their skills that are frequently not as great as their ambitions.
